A memorial service was planned at the Lifesong Funeral Home in Quincy, FL at the convenience of the family.

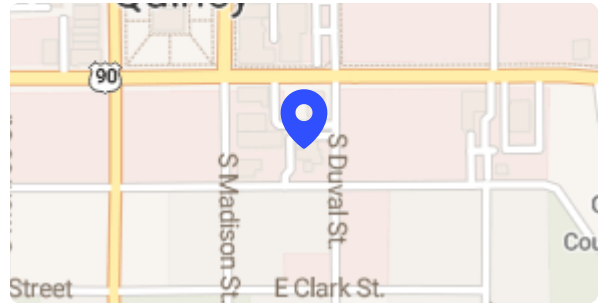
