**N**athan “Nate” Edward Scott, age 54, of Crawfordville, FL left this earth Thursday, January 11, 2018 for his deer stand in the sky.

Nate was born in Quincy, FL, February 22, 1963. He had many interests but was an avid hunter and passionate about his hunting club and fellow hunters. His career in law enforcement included Gadsden County Sheriff Office; Sneads Police Department and Department of Corrections at CMHI in Chattahoochee and ACI in Sneads. 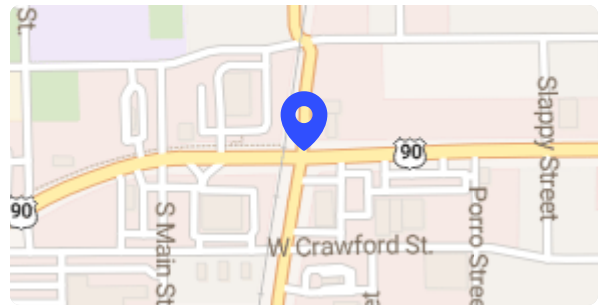

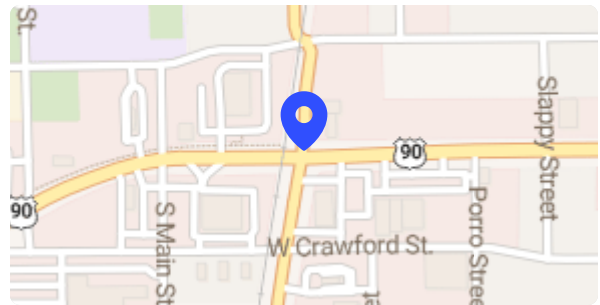
