In lieu of flowers, Ann requested donations to Heifer International or Mercy Corps.

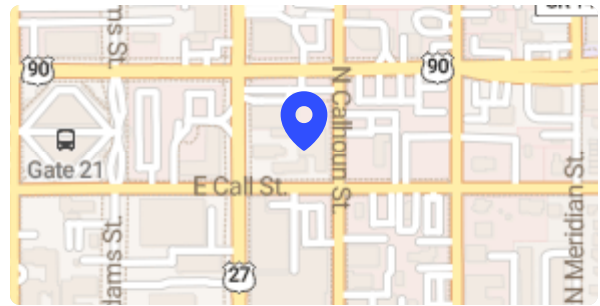
