Todd Gray Standland, a lifelong resident of Quincy, FL, passed away unexpectedly at the age of 55 in his home on July 23, 2021, from natural causes.

Todd was born in Quincy on October 22, 1965 to Bill and Betty Standland. He graduated from Gadsden Christian Academy in 1984. He was primarily self-employed for most of his life, but had recently begun working for Trulieve.

Nicknamed Gator Todd, Todd was an avid University of Florida football fan and would never have been known to miss a game. And if asked about a game, he would always remember every detail, even if the game in question had taken place 30 years ago.
