Robert Richard Skiver Sr., 79, transitioned peacefully to Heaven after a long fight with cancer on December 14, 2023, at his home at Lake Talquin in Tallahassee, FL.

Bob (Bobby) was born in Tallahassee at the Army Hospital on July 12, 1944, the son and only child of Richard Percy and Hazel Inez McDonald Skiver. He spent much of his early years at Lake Talquin where he enjoyed fishing, water skiing and deer hunting. He was a graduate of Leon High School, Class of 1963.
