Together, they owned the Hand, Heart and Mind Studio in Geneva where she was able to showcase and sell her weavings. Linda was a talented artist, specializing in large fiber art weavings featuring notable women. She was an avid baker and gardener and will long be remembered for her homemade breads and beautiful gardens.

In 2013, Linda relocated to Tallahassee, Florida where she enjoyed reading and playing Scrabble. She is survived by her two sons Harold Andrew Berentsen (Rebecca) and Jeremy Oscar Lang (Nancy), her two grandchildren Annika Berentsen and Otto Lang, her brother David Granskog (Heidi) and their six children - David (Sarah), Sarah (Giovanni), Reuben (Hannah), Martha (Dominic), Hannah, and Carl.
